Kitron UAB is an Electronics Manufacturing Services company, and as such procures electronic components and other parts and components to be used in our customers products. Kitron UAB is a downstream user, as defined by the EU regulation of chemical substances and our production processes are compliant with the REACH regulations, including the relation to substances in the SVHC-list (Substances of Very High Concern) (Annex XIV in regulation (EC) No 1907/2006) and the candidate list of SVHC.

Kitron UAB expects its suppliers to act according to the REACH regulations and to exercise due diligence towards their sub suppliers in order to be compliant to REACH regulations for all deliveries made to Kitron UAB.

Suppliers shall provide adequate substance disclosure information to justify that the items they supply are in compliance. For substances on the Candidate SVHC-list a concentration above 0,1 % weight requires disclosure. This must be done in the form of a safety data sheet or otherwise, as required.

The information shall immediately be updated if:

- New information on risk management measures or hazards becomes available.
- An authorization was granted or refused.
- A restriction has been imposed.

If for some reason the supplier is not compliant to REACH regulations we expect proper notice to be given to Kitron UAB.
